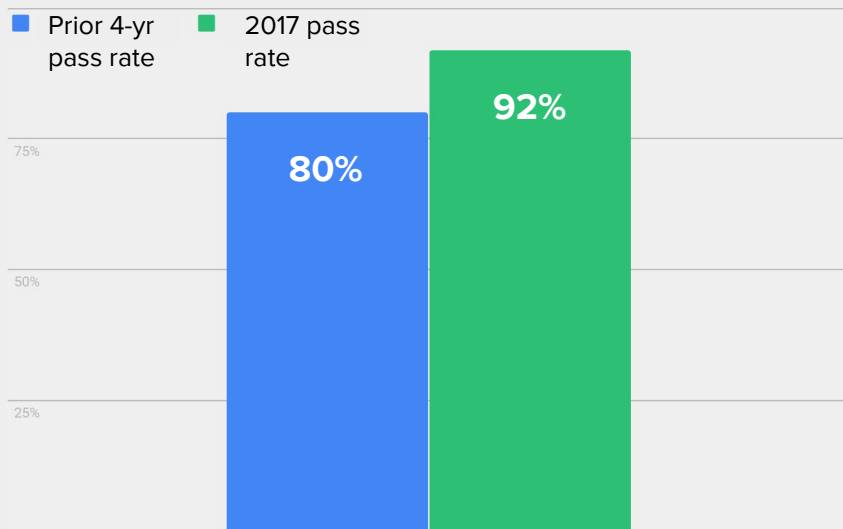
CMCSS is a highly rated, public school district with 35,000+ students in grades PK-12 with 27% of the student population qualifying for FRL. Since 2016, The Graide Network has been working with three public high schools in the district: Rossvie HS, Clarksville HS, and Northeast HS.



Across the district, The Graide Network is used to support secondary ELA courses with the goals of strengthening student writing and expanding teacher capacity.



There is a particular focus on AP® and dual credit courses, which are the most rigorous and writing-intensive. Here, CMCSS teachers leverage The Graide Network to make sure students are writing and revising as much as possible in preparation for college-level writing expectations and end of course exams.



The Results Are In...

CMCSS students who participated in Graide during the 2016-17 school year achieved **record high pass rates** on the AP English Lang exam.

While many factors influence test results, school leadership believes The Graide Network is among the **“most helpful and innovative programs”** they’ve adopted.
