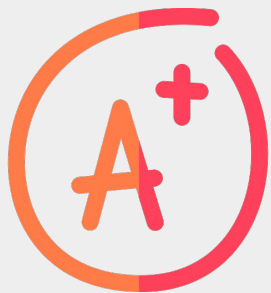
Richmond County Public Schools is an above average public school district with ~1,400 students in grades K-12. They rank in the top 25 of Virginia public school districts. 57% of the student population qualifies for FRL.



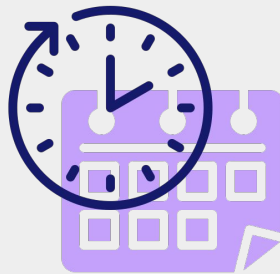
RCPS adopted The Graide Network in 2019 to support all English classes grades 6-12. Their goal was to **prioritize writing, increase feedback for students, and build rigorous ELA practices** district-wide.



During the 2019-20 school year, 4 teachers **saved a total of 216 grading hours** and were able to reinvest that time into data analysis, lesson planning, building extensions and interventions, and 1:1 student support.
